The Project

The project was initiated in late 2005 with the aim to discuss and document current views, mainly in Finland and Sweden, on the use of safety goals, including both benefits and problems.

In this phase of the project the main objective has been to look back and map the evolvement of safety goals for PSA in Sweden and Finland, putting the focus on a number of questions: Where do the safety goals come from? What do they stand for? How are they interpreted? What are the experiences from their use? What are the needs?

The project is financed jointly by NKS (Nordic Nuclear Safety Research), SKI (Swedish Nuclear Power Inspectorate) and the Swedish and Finnish nuclear utilities. It has been performed by Michael Knochenhauer (RELCON AB, Sweden; project manager) and Jan Erik Holmberg (VTT, Finland).
